- h. What do you think is the best way to involve other young people in the effort to create more employment/livelihood opportunities?

7. Group energizer or team-building activity

8. Check for understanding

- a. Review and summarize young people's response to the above questions

- b. Get agreement on what has been recorded/documented

9. Invitation to collaborate

- a. Ask young people if they want to continue engaging with GOYN and collaborate to create and expand opportunities for OY in their community
- b. Ask young people HOW they want to collaborate
- c. Invite young people to join GOYN Youth Advisory calls

10. Reflections and Appreciations

- a. Head, Heart, Feet
 - i. Head – something you learned
 - ii. Heart – something that moved you or inspired you
 - iii. Feet – Something that you will take away and share with others
- b. Appreciations
 - i. Open the meeting to any appreciations youth want to share for individuals, the groups, or the process
